1. Students Eligible for Scholarships:

- a. Seniors enrolled at a high school in Liberty County who will graduate with their class.
- b. Seniors who have applied or have been accepted by a college or university.
- c. Seniors who have a grade point average of 2.5 or better.

2. Students' Responsibility in Applying:

- a. Complete an application and turn it in to the school counselor's office no later than April 21, 2021.
- b. Letter of recommendation from two of your teachers.
- c. An official transcript with current G.P.A. and SAT/ACT score must accompany the application.
- d. Complete an essay as specified on the attached scholarship application.
- e. Annual household income must be listed on the application.
- f. Documentation of community service and/or school involvement must be included with the application.

3. Awarding of Scholarships: Scholarships will be given in the amount of \$1000 per student and will be paid upon proof of enrollment in a college or university.
